If I am pregnant, can the VA help me?

Yes, If eligible for VA services, VA will provide you with prenatal care and delivery by using a community obstetrician.

If I think I have Post-traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) or other mental health concerns, whom can I talk to at VA?

Contact the nearest hospital or VA Medical Center emergency room if you need immediate help. Otherwise, call the VA women's health clinic for information and assistance

Are therapists available if I need help due to sexual assault, domestic violence, or military sexual trauma (MST)?

Yes. All VA medical centers and all Vet Centers have trained trauma therapists. If it is a matter of MST, you are eligible for care even if not eligible for other VA services. It is the law!
